

Construction Council Members Recognized for Safety Excellence

Marquette: Five members of the Upper Peninsula Construction Council were recently recognized by the Michigan AGC for their outstanding safety record. Only 36 contractors across the state of Michigan received the Excellence in Safety Award for zero lost time accidents during the 2007 calendar year. Bacco construction of Iron Mountain was 1 of 2 contractors in the state to receive honor roll status, having just 1 lost time day with over 200,000 man hours worked.
